



## **Dainava Camp Rules 2026**

### **Important Camp Information**

All individuals wishing to participate in the camp must complete the registration form and pay the required registration and participation fees.

The registration and participation fees include accommodation, meals (three times per day), and materials for all camp activities. "Dainava" accommodations are furnished with separate twin-size beds and bunk beds.

All participants are required to bring their own bedding, pillows with pillowcases or sleeping bags, as well as towels and personal hygiene items.

### **General Camp Rules**

The camp will take place from Sunday, August 2, through Sunday, August 9. Arrival is permitted on Sunday, August 2, beginning at 3:00 PM.

During the day, all campers are required to participate in the organized camp program: teachers attend lectures, Lithuanian language learners attend classes, and children (ages 4–18) participate in age-appropriate programming.

All teenagers working at the camp are required to complete their assigned duties.

If you leave the camp grounds, you must notify the camp administration and sign out at the office. Campers under the age of 18 may leave the camp only with prior approval from the administration.

All campers under the age of 18 must remain under adult supervision at all times. Swimming or leaving the camp grounds without adult supervision is strictly prohibited. During free time and evening programs, parents or legal guardians are responsible for campers under the age of 18.

After meals, campers are expected to clear their tables so dining hall staff may clean the dishes and dining area. Dishes, utensils, and food may not be removed from the dining hall.

Please be respectful of others' rest. Quiet hours are observed from 11:00 PM to 7:30 AM.

Smoking of any kind inside camp buildings is strictly prohibited.

The use of cannabis anywhere on camp property, both indoors and outdoors, is prohibited.

Alcohol consumption by individuals under the age of 21 is strictly prohibited.

Campers are strictly prohibited from bringing items that may cause danger or injury, including but not limited to explosives (fireworks), flammable liquids, hazardous sprays, knives, or firearms.

Pets are not permitted at the camp.

The camp hosts maintain a boat on Spyglis Lake. Campers are not permitted to use this boat.

On Sunday morning, all campers must vacate their rooms and leave them clean for camp staff:

White House buildings by 9:30 AM

Barracks by 11:00 AM

The Lithuanian Education Council reserves the right to remove from the camp any individual who fails to comply with these general camp rules.
